Welcome....

We wish all patrons, boxing clubs, officials and most importantly the boxers and fight fans a very warm welcome to the Mountview for our end of season event. And what a third season it has been...

This season Derrylin has won 16 Ulster Titles, 2 CYP Northern Ireland Titles, numerous regional titles but most importantly two National Titles!!

Tonight's programme sees a mixture Derrylin Boxing Club's development squad and our established boxers in action against solid opposition from Monkstown Boxing Club (Dublin) and Carrigart Boxing Club (Co Donegal).

The programme includes two intriguing Female exhibition contests with local girls Helen Moran (Derrylin) and Ciara McGuire (Ballinamore) both pitted against Irish champions. The two local favourites although up against it will no doubt gain invaluable experience.

Derrylin's newest National champion Eligijus Kaupas makes his first appearance on a home tournament and will be aiming for his fifth consecutive win with victory against Dublin Champion Brandon Wall. Also pitted against a Dublin Champion is National Championship finalist & Ulster/CYP NI champion Hanlon Crowley against Kenneth "Dynamo" Doyle.

Derrylin has two other of their Ulster champions in action. Bernard McGovern will be conceding age and experience to the multi-titled National Championship finalist Adrian Cawley (Smithboro), whereas Colm McElhill will be conceding age and weight to Mid Ulster champion Conal McKenna (Emyvale).

In addition we are privileged to host two Tyrone & Fermanagh championship finals, including the all-Derrylin affair (and in fact all Malanaphy family affair) as cousins Anthony and Conor Malanaphy box each other for the Under 15's 46kgs crown.

Finally tonight's programme is wrapped up by two big-hitting intermediate contests. Niall McGovern (Emyvale) this year's Ulster Novice champion faces a stiff test against Mantvydas "Junior" Lukavskis (Dungannon) and then the show closer features the big men.

Anthony "Bomber" McHugh makes his long awaited ring debut against Gerard McCarron. McCarron until a recent comeback fight had been out of action for two years but with 18 contests under his belt has a wealth of experience to call upon and will start a strong favourite.

This will be a very tough contest and baptism of fire for the home favourite but inside the square ring there are never any easy opponents. So from the safe side of the ropes, please sit back and enjoy!!!

We kindly ask that you give all competitors a very warm and friendly Fermanagh welcome and be respectful to all competitors during and after each contest. On behalf of the club we thank you ever so sincerely for coming out to support us once again.
